Each player receives 3,000 in tournament chips

### Rebuy Rules

Any player with 3,000 chips or less can purchase a rebuy during the first 3 rounds prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> break. Any player who loses all their chips can purchase a double rebuy. A rebuy is 3,000 tournament chips for \$300. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> round you may purchase a single or double add-on regardless of your chip stack. You receive 3,000 chips for \$300 or 6,000 for \$600.

5,000 Starting Chips  
30 minute Rounds  
25/50 Starting Blinds
